But God is amazing. We managed to find tickets on the internet to fly to all the cities we need to visit in Arkansas, Michigan, and Wyoming, and back to Hong Kong. We called our travel agent and asked if she could book them for us, and she said she could but we would have to pay for them in 24 hours or they would cancel. We did not have the money but she booked them anyway. That very same day, in our mailbox, all of the money we needed for the tickets showed up. Every penny, right down to the cent. GOD IS AMAZING! We thank all of you who listened to God's call to share, and thank God for His amazing goodness. Here is our itinerary;

- Thu, Apr 26** Arrive Los Angeles
- Fri, Apr 27** Arrive Memphis TN
- Thu, May 3** Arrive Grand Rapids MI
- Thu, May 10** Arrive SLC
- Sat, Jun 30** Return to HK from SLC

Our Schedule in Arkansas as we understand it is that we will be at First Baptist Elizabeth, Sunday morning April 29th. Sunday evening, we will be at First Baptist in Salem, with power point and video presentation. Wednesday evening, May 2nd we will be at Immanuel Baptist Church. We are looking forward to seeing you ALL!

May 3rd through the 9th we are in Michigan visiting with the Graber clan, and Grammy Chod (we hope).

May 10th arrive in SLC, and we will check into a hotel for the night, and catch the shuttle up to Idaho Falls the next day. We will see if we can get the VW working, and we will drive over to Jackson. (Could be an adventure, you never know with the VW!) the mice could have taken over by now, and there may not be anything left of it. ??! Anyway, we probably could be in Jackson by 11th or 12th of May, through the end of June. We are looking forward to speaking at all the churches we spoke at last year, and at this point all of our time is free. If you are interested in us coming to speak again at your church on a given Sunday (or any other day) please email us with the dates you are interested in. We are anxious to speak not only on Sunday services, but at home

Bible study groups, AWANA groups, or weekday evening services. We have prepared a power point presentation, and a short (5 minute) video of the work that is going on here.

More Good News ...

Well, if that is not enough good news for you, we have more. GOD IS AWESOME. We have been praying for a way to stay here in Hong Kong as HK residents. As it is now, we are classified as tourists. We are supposed to leave HK after 90 days, but as we exit HK and enter The Peoples Republic of China, and then return to HK, we kind of fall through the cracks of HK immigration. We asked God that if He wanted us to stay here and continue this work, that He would provide legitimate HK resident status for us. (Not an easy task). New Life League (Our parent ministry, and the printers of the Bibles we carry to China), has extended to us an offer to apply for HK resident status for us. We are honored, and have accepted their invitation.

We will apply for two year China visa's when we are back in America (Please pray that we will get them). New Life will start the HK resident application process for us here in HK after we leave. (Please pray that we are granted HK residents status). The HK resident status would eliminate our immigration difficulties for being here longer than 90 days, would give us reasonably priced quality health care, and would make it generally easier for us to live in Hong Kong. We believe that God has called us to be here for at least the next two years.

Only God could do this.

We meet a lot of people from different walks of life in our work here. People from all over the world, and from varying backgrounds. We have recently met a man that spent most of his life as a secular Jew. In 1993 he accepted Jesus Christ as the Messiah, and gave his life to Him.

Around the same time another man from a different walk of life, a Palestinian, from Gaza, against all his families protests gave his life to Jesus Christ. God brought both of these men here to work at the same time, side by side, being Bible couriers, and taking Chinese Bibles to our

bretheren in China. It was an amazing sight to see both of these men filled with the love of our Saviour, and now for each other. Only God can accomplish such a miracle.
