the border and leave our complex in groups of 6 at a time, and just walk through like we owned the place. We prayed fervently, and then left in teams 15 minutes apart. We marched upstairs to pick up our precious cargo, and then hopped the train for China. As soon as one

team was on the train we started another one off. I have never been in the military but I imagine that's what it must be like. Clockwork. We all carried Sunday school material for children, and we each took one bag apiece. It all seemed kind of like a blur as the border was particularly busy that day. We asked God to make us invisible. That no one would have any issue's or difficulties at the border and you know what. Every single man, women, and child got through with their precious cargo. Not one got stopped, not one got questioned. The total material that got through was enough for 3 years of Sunday school curriculum for 16 individual kids in China. As Gods Word Says;

It never happens that that many people get through all at once. NEVER. But they did and God is GOOD. Well we dropped off out pre-
