Well, we have much to share since the last newsletter. Seems there is much going on here. We had a wonderful Thanksgiving complete with 2 turkey's, gramma Grabers gizzard gravy, and all the trimmings. Deborah and I made the turkeys the day before so we could all celebrate on Thanksgiving. There were only 7 or 8 Americans, and about 25 other nationality's. They were glad to share in the festivities. Seems everyone likes turkey. The Chinese call it Huo Ji. It translates to "Fire Bird".

Not really sure why?

As we were preparing the turkey, being the graceful person that I am, I managed to drop the brand new 8 inch carving knife, and it managed to stick in my foot. Praise the Lord it missed the main artery (I did not have shoes on). It didn't bleed to badly so we thought it was ok, and we just decided to bandage it, and let it heal. Well of course it never really seemed to heal just right so we went to the Dr, and as it turns out it severed my top tendon for my big toe. I will probably have to have some sort of surgery to fix it after it heals properly. As it stands at present, the surface is healing properly, but the tendon is healing incorrectly. My big toe doesn't bend quite right any more, and it is a bit sore.

Other noteworthy news is that our office where we are working at present, has notified all the tenants of the building that they intend to stop any and

all commercial activity in the center. We aren't really commercial

activity because we don't buy and sell things, but they still view us as such. We have a very short time to come up with another office space. God is closing the door for us here in Sheung Shui Center. But I believe He has a better place for us, that is bigger, with warehouse, and office space. He just needs to show us where it is. OUR TIME HERE IS SHORT. Please pray fervently that God would give

us the right office, and the funds to have it. We will of course still be able to live here, and our short term missionaries will still be able to live here, BUT WE CAN NO LONGER MOVE BIBLES FROM HERE. We have maybe two months. There are many office / warehouse spaces within 10 minutes walk, please pray that God would open the door for the right one.

The next bit of news is much more exciting. Deborah and I have been invited to go to Japan in January. Japan is where all of the Chinese bibles are printed, (among other things) and we are going to start the process of designing a web based manufacturing order tracking system for the Printing company. Please pray for wisdom, and communication skills for us for this project. We still are going to be involved in the every day process of LCI, and being Bible couriers, just not so frequently.

The longer we stay at LCI, it seems the more responsibility God is giving us. Deborah has taken over the correspondence managers position while her counterpart is on furlough, (3 Months), but there has been some talk of her keeping it indefinitely. Please pray for her, it is a very difficult job, and she is doing miraculously well.

Deborah and I are having Christmas dinner for the "stragglers" this year. The missionaries who cannot go home, or have no other placed to go. We are going to have turkey again, but this time I am going to wear

steel toed boots! Or maybe use a butter knife to carve it. We have a real live Christmas tree, a Norfolk Island Pine, and we have decorated a bit. It is really funny to go down in the center of our complex, and

look at 6 - 25 story buildings, and see only our lonely little Christmas tree looking out the window at us. What must our neighbors think? I hope they ask, I will gladly tell them about Jesus, and what He has done for me, and what He can do for them!

We recently had the privilege to attend the Franklin Graham Festival here in Hong Kong. We went on the last day, (Sunday). It was held in Hong Kong Stadium. That holds 40,000 people. There were so many more people that came to the festival that HK opened 4 other stadiums and televised the festival on big mega screens (100 X 300 feet), at the stadiums, It was amazing. The last day of the festival there was 120,000 people in attendance at 5 stadiums just on the one day we were there. We hear the number of people that responded were something like 20,000. Praise the Lord, He IS working here in Hong Kong. It was such a spiritual uplifting for us to see. We were so tremendously blessed.
